A Resolution of the City of Angoon, Alaska

A RESOLUTION MANDATING QUARANTINE FOR PERSONS TRAVELING INTO ANGOON RELATED TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death and is caused by the SARS-Cov-2 virus ("virus"), a new strain of the corona virus that has not been previously identified in humans and is easily transmittable person to person; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization ("WHO") declared the virus a pandemic; Alaska Governor Dunleavy issued a declaration of public health disaster emergency in response to the anticipated outbreak of COVID-19 in Alaska; and on March 13, 2020, President Donald J. Trump declared a national emergency in response to the virus pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the State of Alaska issued health mandate 4, which required high risk travelers to quarantine for 14 days and required medium risk travelers to stay about six feet away from people; and

WHEREAS, as of March 20, 2020, the State of Alaska had issued eight health mandates including closing schools until May 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, to date, 32 positive cases of COVID-19 have been identified within the State of Alaska, with one in Juneau; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, the City of Angoon declared a local emergency in response to COVID-19; and


WHEREAS, this resolution shall have the same authority as an Emergency Order issued by the Mayor pursuant to his authority under AMC 2.66.230.


THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, that any person traveling into the City of Angoon by ferry or airplane is required to self-quarantine for 14 days upon arriving at their destination and monitor for symptoms of illness. During travel and following the quarantine period, appropriate social distancing measures must be followed. This self-quarantine requirement also applies to any household members of any traveler, if the traveler practices the self-quarantine at home.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution may also be referred to as "Angoon COVID-19 Rule 1."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be effective upon passage and remain in effect until April 23, 2020, or until the virus is no longer declared a federal or state emergency, whichever occurs first.
