



# COVID-19 Emergency Order 1

## AN EMERGENCY ORDER CLARIFYING AND STRENGTHENING THE CITY OF ANGOON RESOLUTION 20-16 ALSO KNOWN AS THE ANGOON COVID-19 RULE 3 REGARDING TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS RELATED TO COVID-19

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death and is caused by the SARS-Cov-2 virus (“virus”), a new strain of the corona virus that has not been previously identified in humans and is easily transmittable person to person; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization (“WHO”) declared the virus a pandemic; Alaska Governor Dunleavy issued a declaration of public health disaster emergency in response to the anticipated outbreak of COVID-19 in Alaska; and on March 13, 2020, President Donald J. Trump declared a national emergency in response to the virus pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 23, 2020, the City of Angoon declared a local emergency regarding COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 23, 2020, the City Council passed Resolution 20-16, mandating a non-essential travel lockdown related to the COVID-19 Pandemic; and


**WHEREAS**, on March 27, 2020, the City Council passed Resolution 20-17B, mandating a non-essential travel lockdown related to the COVID-19 Pandemic which shall go into effect on April 1, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Alaska Health Mandate 12, Attachment B, “Alaska Small Community Emergency Travel Order”, allows local municipalities with a population of less than 3,000 to enact stricter travel restrictions than provided for in Mandate 12; and

**WHEREAS**, this emergency order is issued by the Mayor pursuant to his authority under AMC 2.66.230.

### BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That all non-resident travelers are banned from entering Angoon. Resident is defined as a person who has physically resided in Angoon for at least 10 of the last 12 months. The only exception is for Essential Workers as defined in section 4 of this Emergency Order.
2. That all resident travelers who are currently away shall return to Angoon as soon as possible and are mandated to self-quarantine, including all household members, for 14 days upon their return.
3. This order supersedes Resolution 20-16 and shall also be referred to as “Angoon COVID-19 Rule 3”
4. Essential Workers are defined as:
  - A. Emergency First Responders
  - B. Law Enforcement acting within their official duties
  - C. Office of Children’s Services personnel responding to reports of child abuse and neglect and insuring child safety.
5. That this Emergency Order be effective immediately and shall remain in effect until April 1, 2020.
